- Degree in theatre, education, or other related field (preferred, but not required)
- Knowledge of theatre basics and basic musical theater dance and singing
- Bilingual a plus (not required)

MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES

- Teach and instruct students using a variety of teaching methods
- Implement curriculum to provide a quality theatrical education for students
- Establish and maintain communication with families, School facility staff members, and Trinity Theatre Company staff
- Attend all staff meetings and trainings required for the teaching position

- Extended teaching hours during School Intercessions (September 19-September 30th)
